General Guidelines

- Organizations must submit a written request to be considered or complete a donation request form
- Organizations should serve our geographic area
- We receive a large number of requests weekly and therefore must limit an organizations request to one per calendar year
- Donations typically range from \$100-\$250 or we may donate a basket for an auction event

Areas of Giving

Grundy Bank favors requests from non-profit organizations that directly relate to:

- Education and youth programs
- Family and community welfare
- Health and human services
- Civic projects and community development
- Performing arts and cultural activities

Limitations & Exclusions

Grundy Bank does not typically support requests from the following:

- Individuals or families
- Political activities or candidates for political office or political organizations
- Paid solicitors
- Advertising in a book or posting a sign at a sports field. These and other like requests are advertising and will be considered under the advertising budget.
